Sport Shooting – Basic Knowledge Training U.S. Forces Handbook & Disciplines

- Each discipline requires use of a specific target (or targets)
- Firearms must be legal within the *Waffengesetz*
- Handguns with barrel under 3" (7.62cm) are illegal
- Some disciplines are only for hunters (or trainees)
- Hearing and eye protection are mandatory

Sport Shooting – Basic Knowledge Training U.S. Forces Handbook & Disciplines

- **Eligibility requirements:**
 - ID card holder
 - Minimum age 18 (21/25) years
 - Background check
 - Liability insurance
 - Basic knowledge training and test
 - Active (18 times per year, ongoing) participation in US Forces Sport Shooting Program, with 12 months of experience
 - Exception: credible proof of shooting sport participation in CONUS

Installation level sport shooting program managers and recreational range masters take a one-day training and certification course.

* Only for persons who are authorized to shoot as hunters (licensed hunters and hunter trainees)

All sport shooting weapons must be in compliance with the legal provisions. Use of weapons which are excluded from use for sport shooting in accordance with §6(1) of the General Ordinance on the Weapons Law (AWaffV) are prohibited.

The minimum barrel length for short hand guns is 3“ (7.62 cm).

Firearms for Sport Shooters

- **Storage of firearms at home in legal gun safe**
- **Legal use (firing) only at certified firing ranges**
 - **Loaded only while shooting at range**
 - **Transport and storage on range only unloaded, out of reach, in a locked container, with bolt/slide open**
 - **Transport from home to range unloaded and out of reach**
 - **Outside of Germany the European Weapons Pass or foreign permit needed**
 - **Purchase of ammo only at range for immediate use or with permit in WBK**

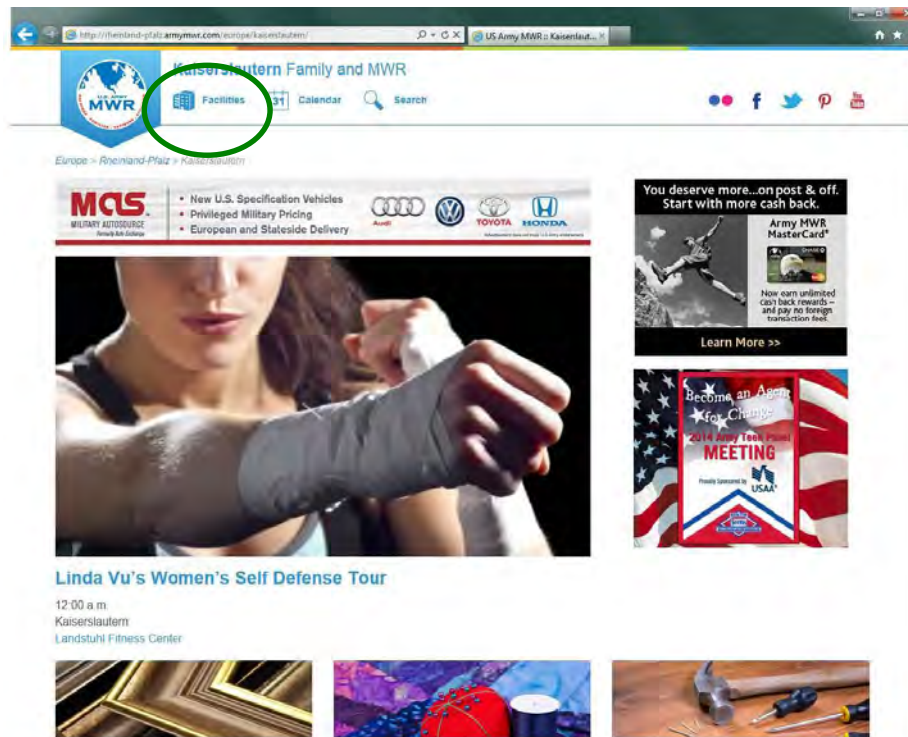

Example Discipline: R 1

Weapon: All revolvers with a 3” barrel length are permitted.

a. Sights

Sights consist of two components: Front and rear sight

b. Trigger

Min. 1000 g. Trigger stop is allowed.

c. Grips

Orthopedic grips and palm-molded surfaces are not allowed.

Calibers: Calibers will be scored in caliber categories

Categories:

Cal 0.0 -.31

Cal .32-45

Magnum Calibers

Ammunition: All commercially available and reloaded ammunition is permitted. All bullet shapes as well as lead, jacketed, partially jacketed and fully jacketed bullets, and bullets with a galvanic or plastic coating are permitted. Black powder loads are not allowed.

Example Discipline: R 1 (continued)

Aiming Position: One-handed or two-handed position

Target: Target No. 1

Distance to Target: 15 m/ 20 m/ 25 m

Number of Shots/Shooting Time: Six series of 5 shots, 60 seconds per series

Sequence:

1. Series 15 m standing
2. Series 15 m kneeling
3. Series 20 m standing
4. Series 20 m kneeling
5. Series 25 m standing
6. Series 25 M kneeling

Shooting Glasses: Shooting glasses of any kind may be worn.

Scoring: Scoring will be accomplished in accordance with general rules.

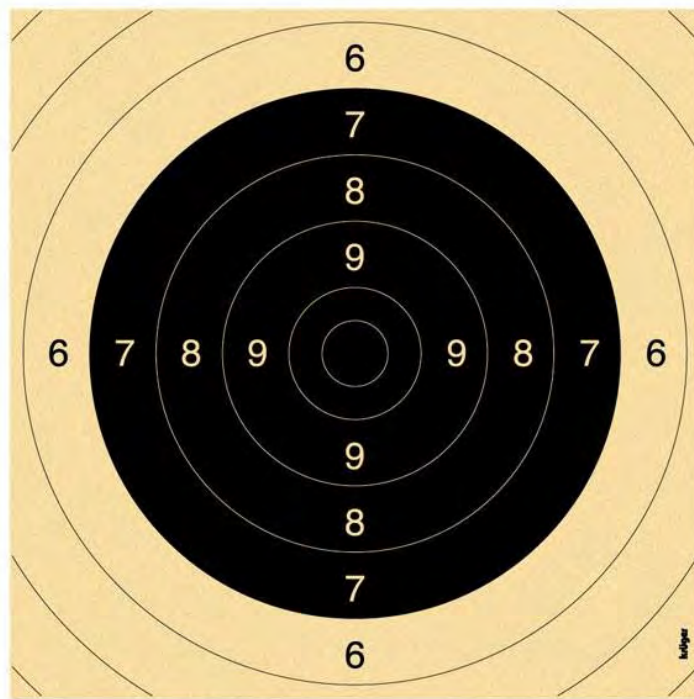

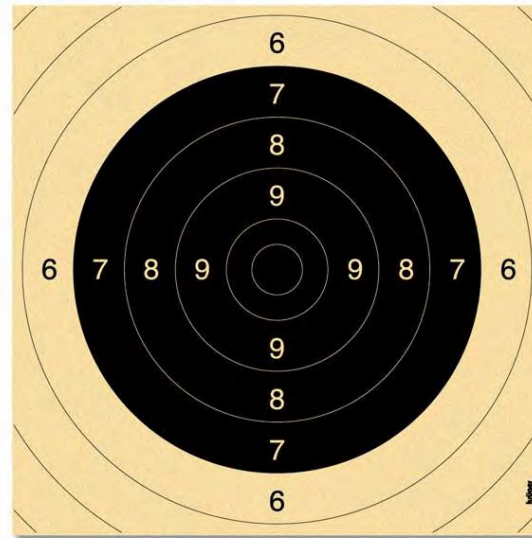

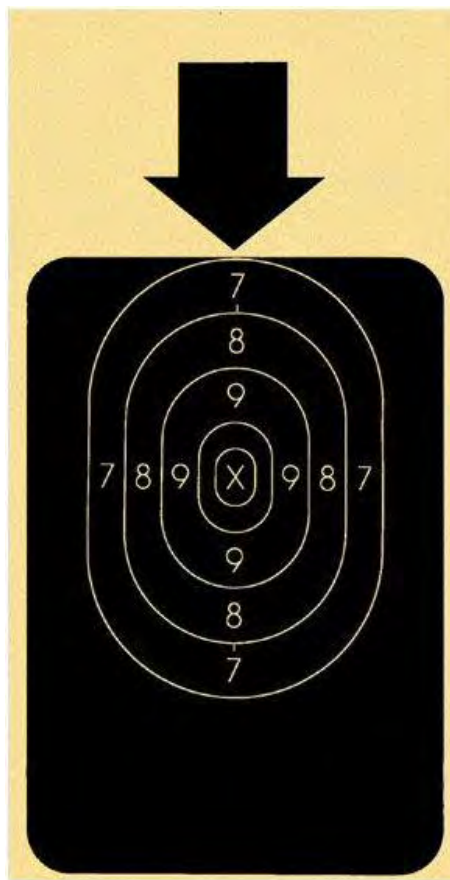

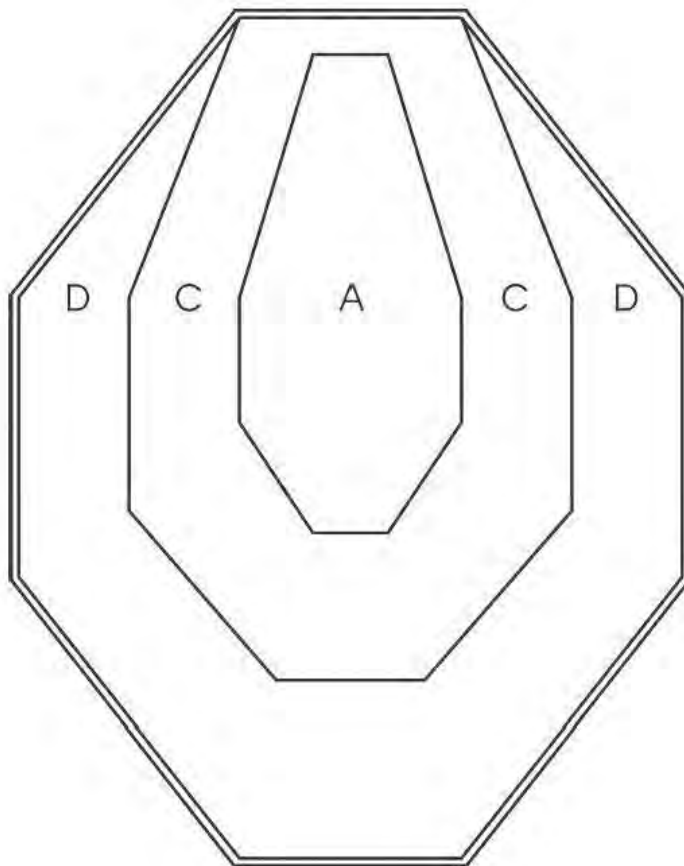
